

Yellow Card Centre North West – ADR reporting third quarter 2018/19 (September to December 2018)

Highlights

- 1,133 reports, reporting in this period is up 15% compared to third quarter 2017, including:
 - 662 hospital reports
 - 433 hospital pharmacist/pre-reg pharmacist
 - 88 hospital pharmacy technician
 - 53 hospital doctor
 - 63 hospital nurse
 - 14 hospital healthcare professional
 - 11 radiographer
 - 212 patient/carer reports
 - 41 community nurse reports
 - 45 GP reports
 - 46 community pharmacist/pre-reg pharmacist reports
 - 17 primary care based pharmacist reports

Figure 1 Reporting by quarter 2015-18

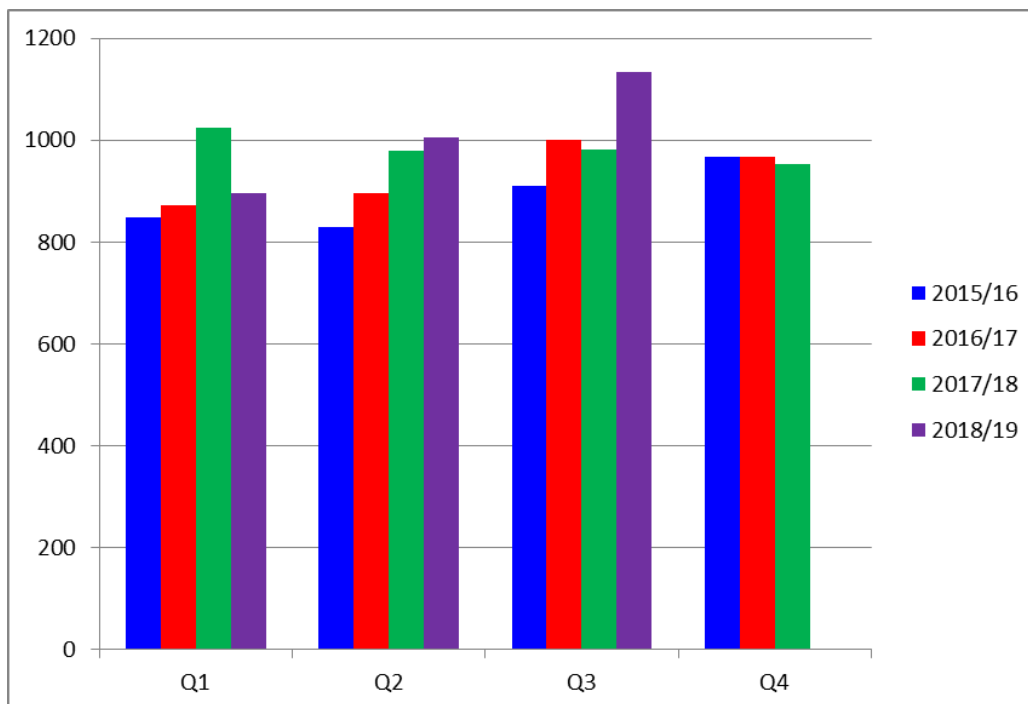


Figure 3 Secondary Care trust reporting per HES (x 100,000) September – December 2018

NOTE: Hospital Episode Statistic data used is for 2017/18

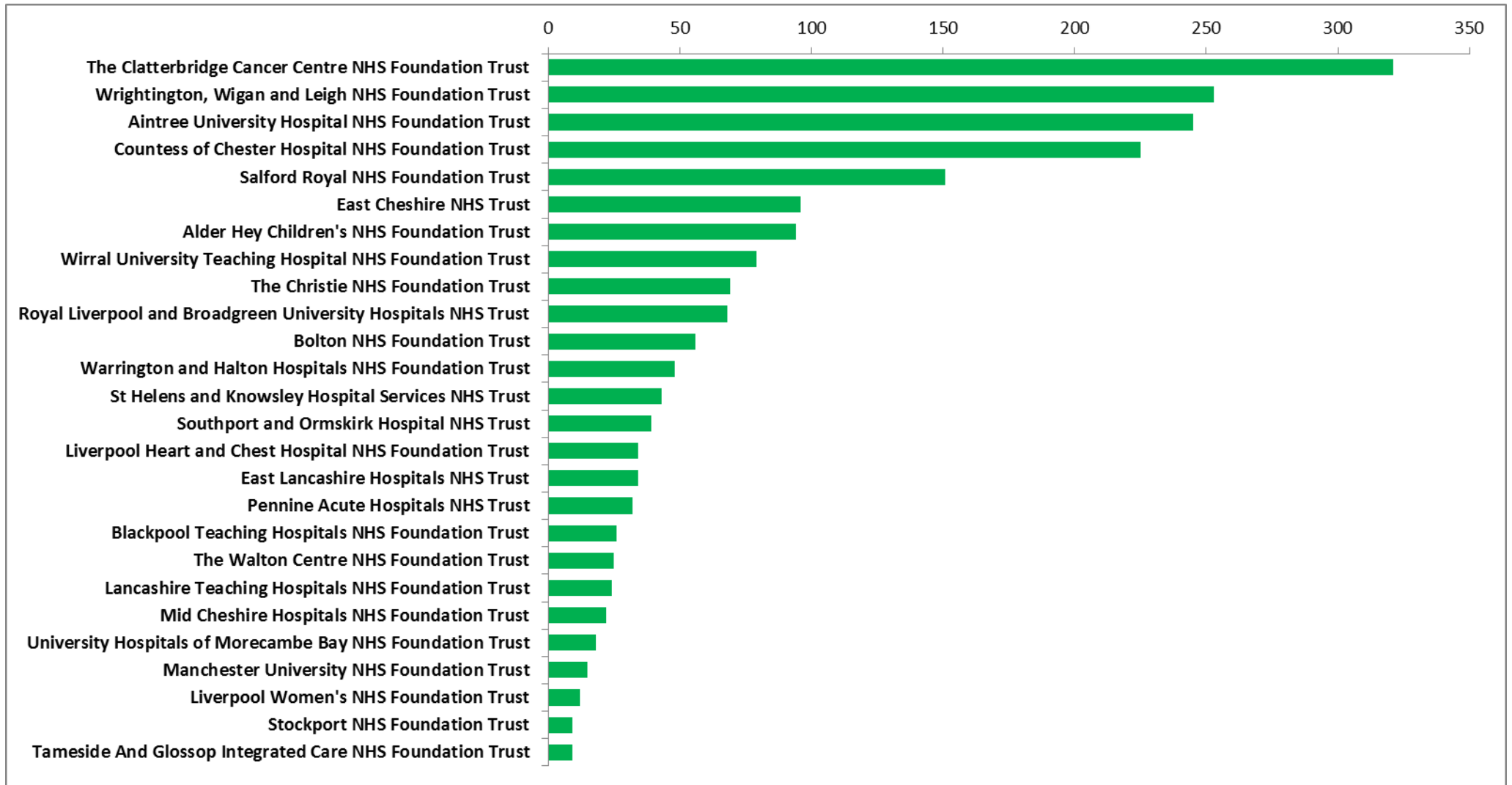


Figure 4 Community and Mental Health trust reporting September – December 2018

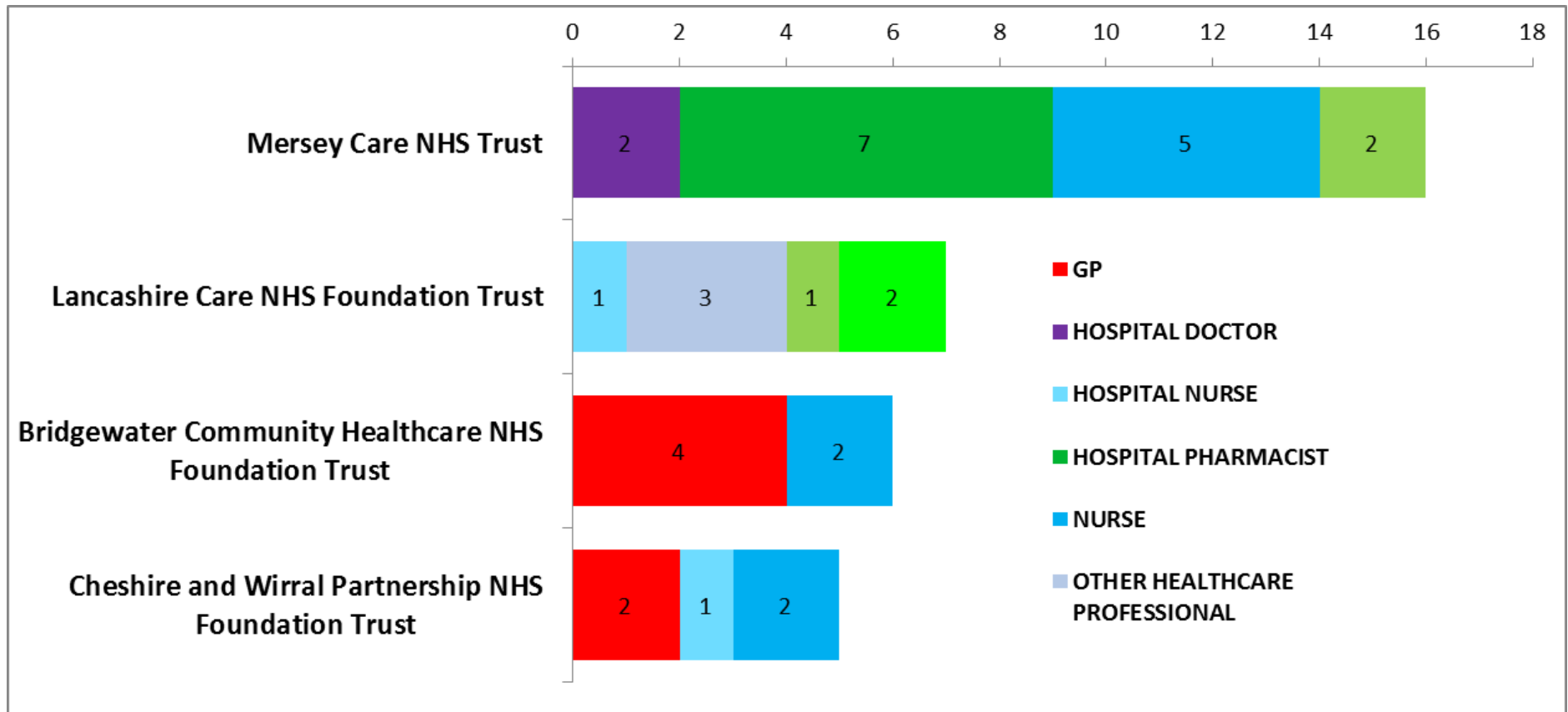


Figure 5 CCG reporting by report type September – December 2018

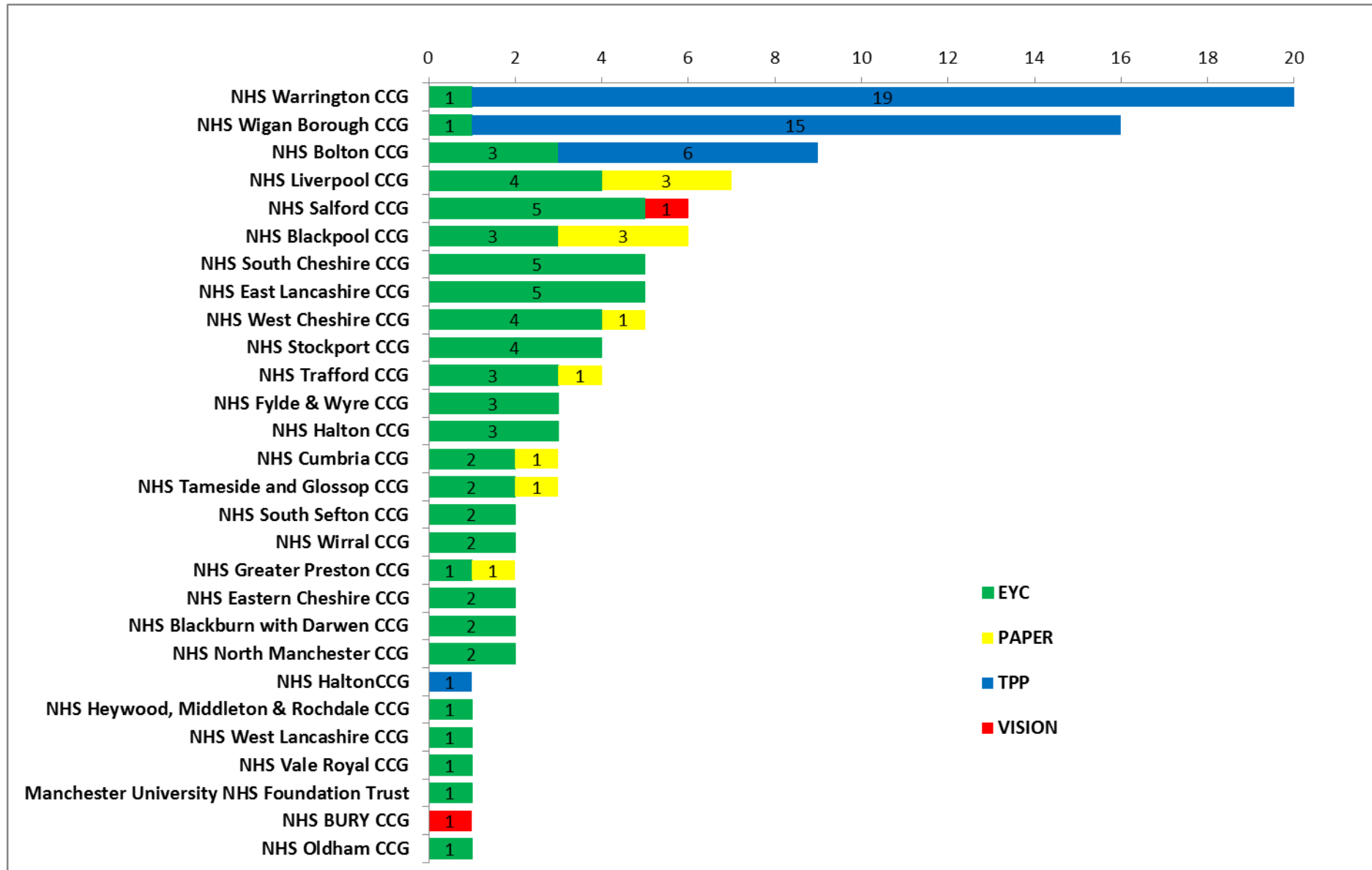


Figure 6 CCG reporting by reporter qualification September – December 2018

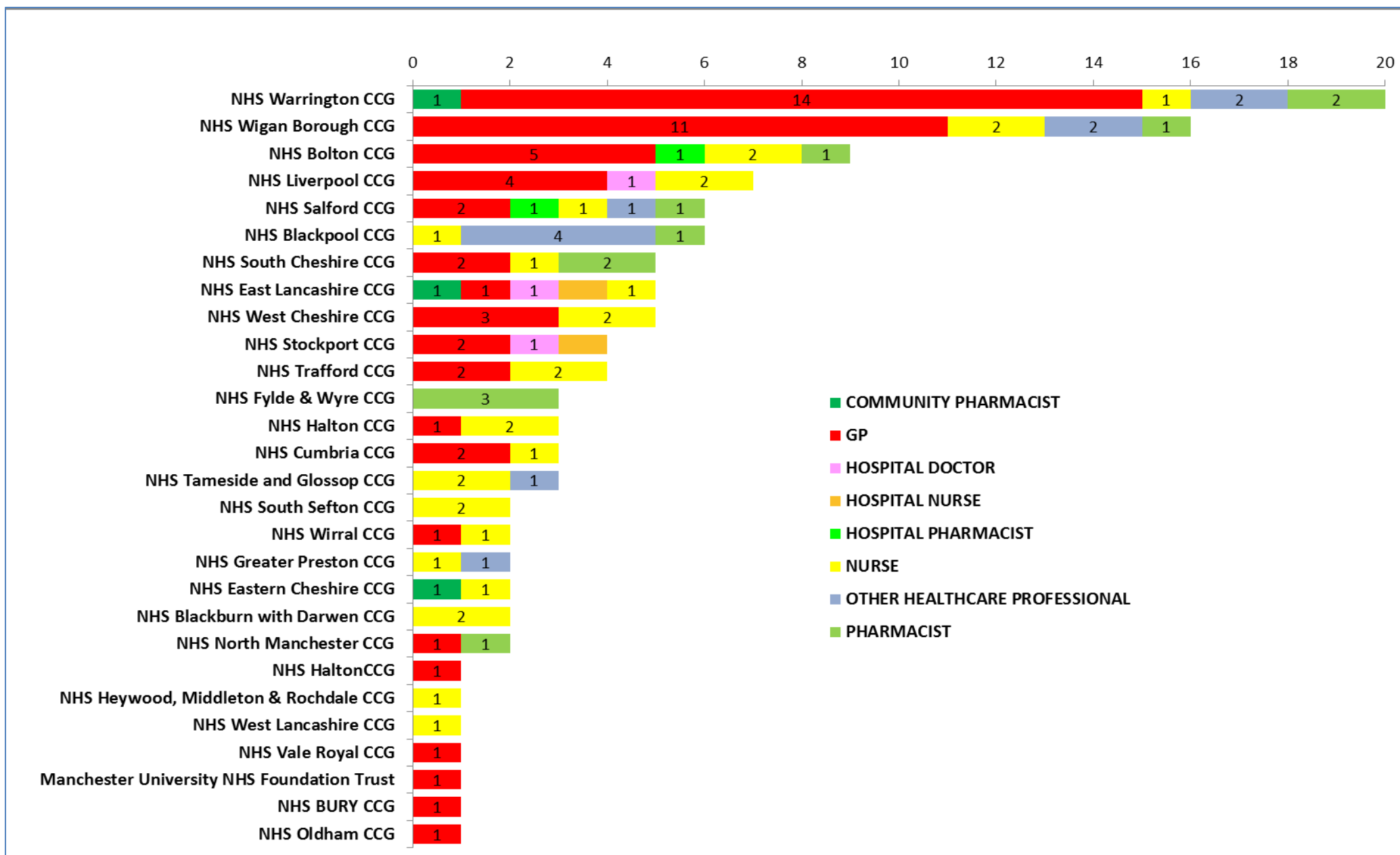
